- 5. Holiday Spicewood American Barleywine style ale brewed with copious amounts of spices, coriander, allspice, nutmeg and crystalized ginger. Just for an extra kick, pounds, upon pounds of cinnamon sticks and toasted oak chips were added. The nose is full of cinnamon, drinks smooth, with a hint of orange and finishes with a slight oakness. - 7. Battle of I-75 IPA-Hazy DIPA. is a collaborative effort between EBW and Juniper Brewing Co. out of Bowling Green. In the spirit of the UT/BG football rivalry, each brewery will brew their own version of a Hazy IPA. The same malt blend was use by each brewery, with the hops and yeast being different. 10. O Tannenbaum-Spruce Tip Ale. Utilizes Fresh spruce tips in the boil as the replacement for some of the hops, normally present for bitterness. The aroma is full of pleasant, but not distracting spruce notes, followed by a unique perfectly balanced spruce flavor component. This is the Christmas ale you have been waiting for.
